Pursuant to our FAA airspace waiver, please find attached on the second page of this letter a Notice to Airmen regarding our temporary aerobatic box at the Casa Grande Municipal Airport on December 4-6th, 2003. As indicated on the NOTAM, the box is located directly to the east of the airport, south and east of the extended runway centerline. Instrument approaches and runway operations will be unaffected, although we ask that all patterns and missed approaches remain to the north and west of the runway centerline. We will monitor and advise on the airport Unicom frequency 122.7MHz.

Notice to Airmen

Aerobatic Competition at Casa Grande Municipal Airport (CGZ)

December 4th – 6th, 2003

Pilots are advised that an Aerobatic Competition will be held at Casa Grande Municipal Airport on December 4th through the 6th, sunrise to sunset and that the area directly east of the field may be heavily utilized by aircraft engaged in Aerobatic maneuvers up to 6000' MSL. All other traffic are advised to use the northwest side of the field (as normal, right traffic for runway 23 and left traffic for runway 5). Inbound aircraft are advised to approach CGZ from the north and west, while keeping a minimum distance of 2nm to the south and east to avoid aerobatic traffic. Practice instrument approaches can be flown as published to runways 23 or 5, although circling and missed approaches should be kept to the northwest side of the extended runway centerline. Unicom (122.7MHz) will be monitored at all times during aerobatic activity for traffic advisories.
